One of the most urgent environmental problems in the world today is the shortage of clean water. Acid rain, industrial pollution and garbage have made many sources of water undrinkable. Lakes and entire seas have become vast pools of poison. Lake Baikal in Russia, one of the largest lakes in the world, contains a rich variety of animals and plants, including 1,300 rare species that do not exist anywhere else in the world. But they are being destroyed by the massive volumes of industrial wastes which pour into the lake every day. Even where law existed, the government did not have the power to enforce them.

The Mediterranean Sea occupies 1% of the world's water surface. But it is the dumping ground for 50% of all marine pollution.
